Leadership Meadville #15: Health & Wellness Day

Health & Wellness Day kicked off with a delightful breakfast where we shared updates from our peers about their businesses and received exciting news about upcoming Chamber events, thanks to Christa Lundy. We started the day with two captivating book reviews on leadership by our peers. These reviews are a personal favorite of mine, as they provide a glimpse into classmates' perspectives on leadership, helping us understand and get to know one another better.

The day continued with engaging group activities led by Gary Svetz, focusing on Connecting Trust & Conflict. We explored the significance of our "Why" and discussed how leaders can establish transparency as a core value. Our discussions touched on differentiating between negative and positive conflict, offering invaluable insights.

Our journey took us to MMC Vernon Place, where we received a fascinating tour from Anne White, Vice President of Rehabilitation and Outpatient Services. We learned about the array of medical services offered and the building's rich history, including the addition for the MRI machine. Anne's passion for their services was truly inspiring. A presentation followed from Heather Frazier the Vice President of Human Resources, who shared her leadership approach of having no personal agenda and emphasized treating others as you wish to be treated.

After a delicious lunch, we participated in a panel discussion at MMC Vernon Place featuring Diane Craven from the Free Clinic and Melissa Swartwood of Hospice. Diane shared that the Free Clinic provides essential services to uninsured individuals, alongside a "Pass it On" program for donated medical equipment. Melissa highlighted Hospice's services for all ages, their wish fulfillment program, and support groups for grief and loss.

Our adventure then led us to Good Karma Jiu Jitsu Academy with owner Jaroslav "Yoda" Botka, where we experienced Jiu Jitsu instruction. Yoda taught us fundamentals, using our voice for defense, and made our day by guiding us through energetic demonstrations, including a fun flip! We also discovered the enriching history of Gracie Jiu Jitsu.

Last but not least, we visited Vitality Natural Health & Wellness Center, which impressed us with its client-centered functional medicine approach. This method focuses on addressing root causes of diseases and promoting optimal wellness, benefiting our community immensely.

Throughout the day, the interactions with presenters and fellow Leadership Meadville #15 participants were very engaging. 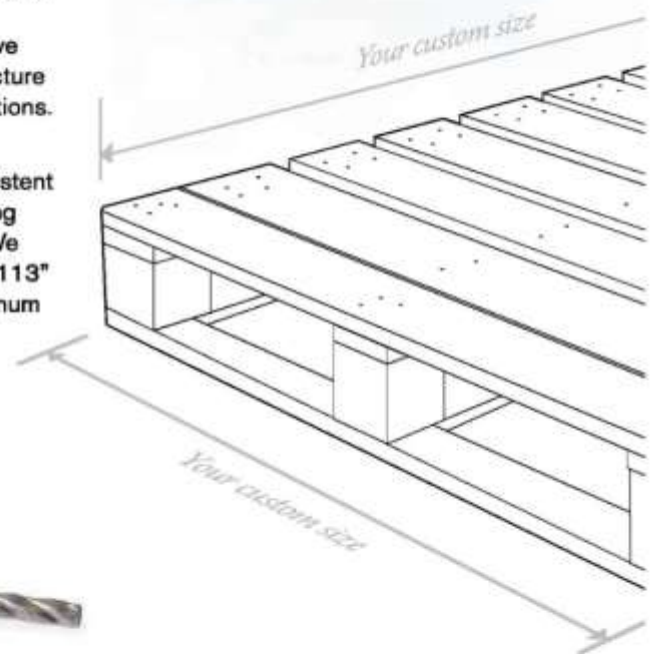

Day 1 - Pittsburgh (PIT)/Rome

Check in at Pittsburgh International Airport for a connection (or direct) flight to Rome. Overnight on the flight.

Day 2 - Rome

From Piazza Malpighi walk to Piazza del Nettuno and Piazza Maggiore, then King Renzo Palace Palazzo Podesta and the Basilica of San Petronio. Drive to Padova, with Sant' Antonio Basilica, one of the most visited churches by pilgrims of the Catholic world. Drive to Venice, the City of Love. Private water-taxi transfer to Piza San Marco, visit St Mark's Basilica. Sightseeing also includes the Palazzo dei Dogi, the legendary "Bridge of Sights", roaming along Venice's canals.

Day 8 - Venice/Milan

Depart from Piazzale Roma to Milan, visit the Cathedral Metropolitandi Santa Maria Nascente Duomo di Milano.

Day 9 - Milan/Pittsburgh (PIT)

Take connection flight to Pittsburgh International Airport.
