Today was a bittersweet day, as it marked the final session the Leadership Meadville Class of 2025. The nine month journey ended with Economic Development Day and Results.

We began our field visits with Rob Smith at Cussewago Square. To have an idea and a dream is one thing, and to have a vision is another. Rob's vision turned a blighted area into an incredible must-go-and-see destination in the Meadville community. Soon to be open to the public, the square will offer an outdoor theater/stage for Meadville Community Theatre; an arts building where French Creek Arts Collective can host workshops and classes, as well as attract visiting artists; an incredible new restaurant – DOMINICO's; and an additional home for Cup and Spoon. Located next to Ernst Trail, the opportunities to further develop and connect the community have already taken root, with plans to connect the recreation component to



this site. Through all of the ups, downs, and detours along the way to get to this point of the journey, Cussewago Square taught many lessons to those involved. Be flexible, be patient, learn from mistakes (they are often hidden opportunities), and do not be afraid to grow your dreams! Rob capitalized on these attributes, and many others, and we were grateful for the insight he offered, as well as the sneak peek.

The next stop was the Economic Progress Alliance of Crawford County hosted by Angela Annibale and Jim Becker. The EPACC is a valuable asset to Crawford County. They have a wealth of knowledge of how-to, where-to, and who-to connect with when it comes to development and planning. With several locations in the county, you can count on their support to foster growth in the community.

With the EPACC adjacent to a section of the Ernst Trail, we hooked up with Katie Wickert, who guided us along French Creek to Voodoo Brewing Company (we will get to that in a minute). Did you know that Katie is full of fascinating facts about parks and outdoor recreation in PA? With over 86,000 miles of rivers, the opportunities for people to visit, utilize, and enjoy the outside environment is endless. It takes work. Get involved! Get outdoors! Volunteer! Get healthy! 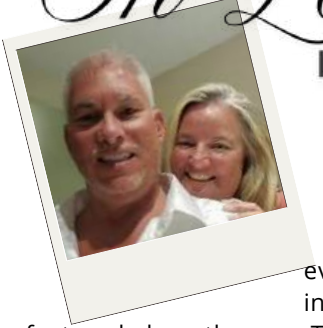

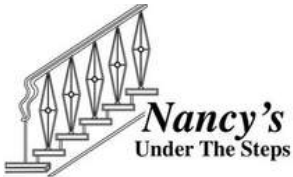
