## Program Updates by Amy Godwin

April did not disappoint! We had a wonderful month loaded with activities and events exposing students to a wide variety of career opportunities. The support of the Crawford County businesses continues to warm my heart. We are working together to build young leaders within our community, and I feel so blessed to be a small part of it! I have highlighted some of the events below.

I had the opportunity to join a small group of students from Meadville Area Senior High School for an Autism Career Days field trip to Vallonia Industries. We explored the employment opportunities available through Vallonia and received a tour of the facility. We concluded the day with a lunch outing where the students were able to work on their social skills.

I had the pleasure of supporting the NWPA Chapter of NTMA RoboBOTS competition again this year. The NTMA always does a great job organizing this event, and the students work hard preparing their BOTs for competition. We had a total of 26 teams competing in the event. Congratulations to all the award winners this year! Keep up the great work!

We welcomed over (750) 8<sup>th</sup> graders to Allegheny College for the 2026 Crawford County 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Career Awareness Fair. The students explored the diverse career opportunities available through approximately (50) vendors that joined us for the day. Through this event the students gain exposure to the local job market and may begin thinking about which career path interests them most. A huge Thank You to Allegheny College for partnering with me each year to bring this experience to the students!

In conjunction with PennWest University, Rosedale Technical, Laurel Technical Institute, and PA State Police we spoke with 10<sup>th</sup> graders at Cambridge Springs Jr/Sr Highschool regarding post-secondary pathway options. These discussions are an important step in preparing students for life after graduation. No matter if students pursue immediate employment, postsecondary education, skilled trades, military service, or civil service roles, our commitment is to guide each one toward the pathway that reflects their unique goals, interests, and strengths.

In partnership with the NWPA Chapter of NTMA we provided the 2026 Passport to Manufacturing event for students in 4<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grades and their families. The students and family members received tours of (3) Manufacturing facilities and finished the day with tours of Crawford Tech shops, lunch and prize giveaways. Thank you to Crawford Tech, Chipsco, Pheonix Laser Solutions, C&J Industries, and Acutec Precision Aerospace, Inc. for opening your doors to the families and helping this event be a success!

Meadville Area Senior High School hosted a Job Hiring Fair for their 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. I was honored to support the event as we welcomed over (30) businesses with current open positions available. Helping the students and businesses make these connections is a vital part of a thriving community.

As I look forward to winding down another academic year, I want to take a moment to wish all the graduating seniors of 2026 the best of luck in your future endeavors! You will do great!
